

Etiquette at Atrisco Heritage High School

1. Please use the trash cans. Do not leave trash on the tables or benches or outside. We have only one custodian supporting the EE tournament, so please be kind and help them out by cleaning up after yourselves.

2. Any spill or something not working, for example, lights out in a bathroom, leak or clog in a toilet, paper towels or toilet paper running low, trash can overflowing, etc. please report to the custodian directly or text Katy Hammel at (505) 967-6094 right away so we can remedy.
