English Expo is New Mexico's premier annual competition for middle and high schoolers in skills of English Language Arts.

- English Expo is run by a registered non-profit organization with board members from around the State of New Mexico
- English Expo is sanctioned by the New Mexico Activities Association
- First Place winners are State Champions
- All contests are aligned to Common Core State Standards
- ELA, Speech, Drama, Art, and Special Education teachers of New Mexico students may coach English Expo students and are asked to judge other contests
- English Expo can be curricular; class or club or genius hour time can be used to prepare students for competition
- Low entry fee, typically \$15/student or less, plus a modest school materials fee
