New Mexico English Expo and the New Mexico Press Women proudly offer a special contest to NM students, grades 6-12

Profiles in Courageous Communication *Celebrating 75 years of the New Mexico Press Women!*

Contest Requirements:

Individual students will research and write an essay **highlighting a courageous woman in communications** and then present this essay in an oral presentation which will take place at the NM English Expo 2024 starting at 12 noon on Saturday, Feb. 24, 2024, at Atrisco Heritage High School. This oral presentation can be made in person or via Zoom. Both the quality of the essay and the oral presentation will be part of the overall score for each individual student.

This woman can be from New Mexico, the United States, or the world. The rule is that the woman must be (or have been) involved in the business of communications, such as a reporter, photographer, editor, camera operator, advertising, designer, writer, broadcaster or journalism educator. This woman may be alive or dead. The student's essay MUST be sure to clarify how this woman contributed to the field of communications in a courageous way and what her specific role in the communications field is/was.

Finished essays should be typed double spaced in 12 point Times New Roman with one-inch margins on all four sides. **Essays may not exceed 500 words.** The essay should include a **cover sheet** with the student's name, school, grade, email, and phone number, as well as the sponsoring teacher's name and email. Students **may** include a separate sheet listing the sources for the students' research, using MLA style. This resource list cannot exceed one page and is NOT required.

The **oral presentation** cannot use any audiovisual aids or posters and **must conclude in three** (3) minutes. Students are encouraged to practice their presentation in order to meet this time limit. The topic of the presentation should be the same courageous woman in communications who is discussed in the submitted essay.

All students in NM schools (public, private, and/or charter) in grades 6-12 are eligible to compete. Home-schooled students (grades 6-12) may compete with the home school supervisor/parent signing the entry form in lieu of the teacher/administrator.

A rubric for the scoring of the essay and the oral presentation is included in this packet and should be used as a student completes his/her work.

Contest Submission Rules:

Completed essays must be submitted as PDFs to Pat Graff at <u>PGraff@aol.com</u> NO LATER THAN 8 p.m. MST on Friday, Feb. 16. Late entries cannot be accepted. Completed essays must be accompanied by a completed and signed entry form, also due at 8 p.m. MST on Friday, Feb. 16. Contest sponsors are NOT responsible for last-minute submission issues. Students are encouraged to **submit earlier** than the final deadline time and date. An email will be sent acknowledging the receipt of the completed essay and form.

Students will be notified of their oral presentation time no later than Tuesday, Feb. 20. ALL oral presentations will be made 12-2 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 24, either in person at Atrisco Heritage Academy High School in Albuquerque OR by a Zoom link. The student is responsible for having the necessary device and internet connection to log in to the Zoom meeting. Failure to make an oral presentation will result in the disqualification of the essay.

Winners will be notified by March 1, 2024.

Contest Winners:

Champions will be named at both the junior level (grades 6-8) and the senior level (grades 9-12)

Winners in each category will be **invited to read their winning essays at the 2024 NMPW Conference in March 2024.** The conference is March 15-16, 2024, at Isleta Resort, just south of Albuquerque. Specific times for the presentation will be shared with the winners.

Winners in each category will also receive a cash prize of \$100. As a professional organization of communicators, NMPW members insist that these contest winners be paid for their work, just as other professionals are.

NOTE: This competition is being held as a joint activity between NM English Expo and NM Press Women. It is NOT an official English Expo contest, so no English Expo medals will be awarded.
